Environmental Engineering is the branch of engineering concerned with the protection of the quality of natural living spaces, the prevention and restoration of pollution and the provision of environmental conditions suitable to human health. The emergence of Environmental Engineering was simultaneous with the development of technology, acceleration of population growth, change in socio-economic structure and the large-scale increase in environmental pollution.

The department aims to educate specialists in the harmonization with the environment of investments in the agriculture, industrial, transportation, tourism and energy sectors which form the basis of progress for the completion of the process of development. The department initially focused on





drinking water supply, purification and distribution, waterborne diseases, wastewater disposal and decontamination, later including in its field of interest other elements like the air and the soil which form the environment.

Our vision is to give our students an education enabling them to define the multidimensional problems in their field and to produce technically and economically suitable and sustainable solutions with a global and interdisciplinary outlook.

The department has two divisions and its academic staff includes 4 professors, 12 assistant professors and 14 research assistants.
